



Redeemer Day School Potty Training Policy

All children in our 3 Year Old, Pre-Kindergarten and Transitional Kindergarten classes must be fully potty trained and independent in the restroom. This means they must be able to tell a staff member when they need to use the restroom, wipe and dress themselves without assistance. We do not have facilities for changing pull-ups or diapers at this age and in these classrooms (All students must attend school in underwear). Should a child in these classes be unable to complete these tasks by the first day of school, they will be excused from class until the time they are fully potty trained and independent in the restroom. If a child is excused for potty training concerns, the spot will be filled with another student unless the monthly tuition is paid to hold the spot until the child is able to return. Please recall per our tuition policy, all registration fees are non-refundable for any reason. We do understand that occasional potty accidents happen so please pack a change of clothes including shirts, pants, underwear, socks and shoes in their backpacks.

Children being potty trained in the Early Preschool classes (our 2 year old programs) must wear pull-ups until they are accident free at home and at school for THREE weeks. This means we will start working with the child while they are still in their pull-ups (Velcro sided pull-ups are preferred). We will not remove the child's pull-ups and transfer to underwear until they are accident free at home and at school consistently for THREE weeks. They must also be able to tell the teachers when they need to go to the restroom and be willing to use the classroom restroom. Teachers will assist child in pulling up and down child's clothing to assist in the potty training process. Please dress your child in attire that is easy for them to pull up and down as well as free of complicated fastenings. Please remember that buttons, zippers and/or snaps are hard for children. When the potty training transition begins from pull ups to underwear, the parents must provide a sufficient amount of clothing including shirts, pants, underwear, socks and shoes in their backpacks in the event more than one set is needed throughout the day. We are excited that we have the opportunity to help your child take this big step. We look forward to making this a successful achievement for them.
